



#### **Exam Skills and Practice**

This module focuses on developing your exam skills through exploration and practice of strategies and techniques needed for the Language Exit Exam used for progression to the intended degree programme.

#### **Grammar and Sentence Structure**

The module enhances your linguistic ability and knowledge of the complex English grammar and sentence structure used in formal academic writing and speaking texts.

#### Language for Study 3

This module enhances and develops your ability to understand spoken and written discourse, and use information appropriately in spoken and written academic contexts.

#### Life in the UK

The module aims to combine an overview of the structure of British society with an awareness of the history and culture of the local area in which the you live and study.

#### Personal Development and Progression Project

This module introduces key personal development ideas and learning techniques, as well as research and report writing techniques, equipping you with key skills for success on their intended degree.

#### **Progression Project**

This module aims to enhance your knowledge of your proposed field of study by carrying out secondary and primary research for a project report on a topic of your choice.
